Over nearly level pasture land, through scattered sagebrush, rabbitbrush, greasewood and meadow grass.

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GENERAL DESCRIPTION	
<p>The area surveyed within Township 38 North, Range 59 East, is nearly level to rolling land. The elevation ranges from about 5,400 to 5,500 ft. above sea level. The soil consists of sandy clay, gravelly and rocky in the higher elevations and with silt loam along the Marys River. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood, rabbitbrush and native grass with willows along the river.</p> <p>The township is drained by the Marys River, which flows southerly through the eastern portion of the township.</p> <p>The Cross Ranch is located within section 26 and access into the area is provided by numerous improved and unimproved desert trail roads.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
