	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 19 South, Range 61 East is predominantly rolling with the elevation ranging from about 2,000 to 2,700 ft. above sea level. The soil is mostly sandy loam with some very rocky areas across the northern part of the township. The vegetation consists of mesquite, creosote brush, Brigham tea, yuccas, shadscale and many different cacti.
	There are numerous trail roads that are extensions of the major streets of the City of North Las Vegas and other cross country trails that provide access through out the township. The major drainage of the area is Las Vegas Wash, which drains irregularly SE., entering the area surveyed in section 8 and exiting in section 24. The other washes drain predominantly northerly or southerly into Las Vegas Wash. There is a concrete pole power line crossing the township in an easterly and westerly direction, entering the area surveyed in section 13 and exiting in section 17. There are developments in the southern parts of sections 22 through 24.
