10.60	Fence, bears ESE. and WNW., 0.92 chs. dist. to fence corner, from which fence bears ESE. and SW.
12.50	Trail road, bears NE. and SW., leave meadow, bears NW. and SE., over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush, rabbitbrush and native grass.
19.951	Point for the NW $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of sec. 28, at intersection with the E-W center line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a DEEP-1 magnetic marker, with brass cap mkd. NW $\frac{1}{16}$ S 28 1992 Set a steel fence post, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.

25.30	Improved gravel road, bears NW. and SE.

	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The area resurveyed and surveyed within Township 30 North, Range 56 East, is situated about 1 mile NNW. of Jiggs, Nevada. The elevation ranges from about 5,400 to 5,600 ft. above sea level. The land is nearly level to rolling. The soil is sandy clay and gravelly, with silt loam along Smith Creek, which flows northwesterly through the southwest portion of section 28.
	Principle users of the area are cattlemen and access into the area is provided by improved and unimproved roads.
	No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey. <hr/>
