	<p>From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an aluminum post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 28 N., R. 56 E., executed under Group No. 588.</p>
	<p>N. 5°44.8' W., bet. secs. 34 and 35.</p>
	<p>Over rolling reseeded land, through scattered sagebrush and crested wheat grass.</p>
19.40	<p>Fence, bears E. and W.</p>
40.150	<p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 34 and 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a DEEP-1 magnetic marker, with brass cap mkd.</p>

	<p>Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p>
60.225	<p>Point for the N 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 34 and 35.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a DEEP-1 magnetic marker, with brass cap mkd.</p>

	<p>Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p>
76.00	<p>Fence, bears ENE. and WSW.</p>
80.300	<p>The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, identical with Angle Point No. 4, Lot 16, sec. 27, monumented with a deeply embedded collar of stone, with a rebar in the center 5/8 in. diam., 16 ins. long, exposed 4 ins. above the ground. This point is locally recognized as the true corner point and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.</p>
