

TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 56 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 29 North, Range 56 East, is nearly level to rolling. The elevation ranges from about 5,600 to 5,800 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, native grass and crested wheat grass.

The area is drained by Corral Creek, which flows north-north-west through section 15.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
