From the cor. of secs. 12 and 13, on the E. bdy. of the Tp.

WEST, bet. secs. 12 and 13, on a transit line describing the
tangent.

Over rolling mountainous land, through scattered undergrowth.

22.79 Intersect the E. bdy. of sec. 12, T. 37 N., R. 52 E.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 12 and 13, N. 1° 01' E.,
0.1 lks. from the tangent.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2¹/₂ ins. diam., 16 ins.
in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to
top, with brass cap mkd.
