Intersect the E. bdy. of sec. 1, T. 37 N., R. 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.

The closing cor. of Tps. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 53 E., monumented with a granite stone, 16X10X9 ins., plainly mkd. with 6 notches on N., S. and E. faces and "CC" on E. face, firmly set in a mound of stone, with a steel fence post set alongside.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit the original cornerstone and reset the steel fence post, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, E. of cor.

From this cor., the cor. of Tps. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., monumented with a iron post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 38 N., R. 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., executed under Group No. 574, bears N. 0° 04' W., 6.52 chs. dist.

From this same cor., the E $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. 37 N., R. 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., hereinafter described, bears S. 0°04' E., 33.61 chs. dist.
