32.80	Improved road, bears NNW. and SSE.
39.70	Trail road on curve, from NW. to NE.
40.02	Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2^{1}/_{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	Set a steel fence post, $5^1/_2$ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.
	From this corner, a white PCV pipe, 6 ins. diam., firmly set in concrete and exposed 36 ins. above ground, bears N. 87° 18' W., 1.53 chs. dist.
	From this same corner, a rebar, $^{5}/_{8}$ in. diam., with cap mkd. 1-6-7-12 RLS 6934, firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above ground, bears N. 86° 09' W., 1.53 chs. dist.
	The positions of these monuments are incorrect due to the recovery of original evidence at the $^{1}/_{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, and are not utilized in the course of this survey.
	N. 0° 25' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.
:	Over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush, native grass and juniper.
25.00	Low saddle, bears NE. and SW.
40.02	The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with a redwood post, 3 ins. square, 36 ins. long, with illegible scribe marks visible, loosely set in a mound of earth.
