

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE NORTH BOUNDARY,
T. 14 N., R. 18 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

A sawed fir stump, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 85° E., 58 lks. dist., with chaining notch and portion of scribe mark T visible on decayed blaze.

No evidence of SE. bearing tree.

True cor. point not remonumented due to danger of destruction by further erosion. Cor. point falls at edge of eroded shoreline on sandy soil, bank bears N. 50° E. and S. 50° W.

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
Butler Ives in 1861

From the cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25, and 26, monumented with a mound of stone, 4 ft. diam., with charred wood remains, 2 ins. diam., 5 ins. long in center, no marks visible, from which the original bearing trees

A red fir, 32 ins. diam., bears N. 32° E., 72 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A red fir, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 37° E., 33 lks. dist., with healed blaze. (Record, S. 35° E., 32 lks.)

A red fir, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 36° W., 25 lks. dist., with healed blaze. (Record, S. 41° W., 20 lks.)

A red fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 44° W., 90 lks. dist., with scribe marks 23 visible on portion of chopped open blaze. (Record, 92 lks.)

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground with a magnet at base, and in a collar of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

Cor. is located on NW. slope, at E. side of draw, slopes N., and 60 ft. W. of spur, slopes S.

N. 0°04'40" W., bet. secs. 23 and 24.

40.224 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 23 and 24, at proportionate dist.; there is no evidence of the original cor.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground with a magnet at base, and in a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
