

TOWNSHIP 14 NORTH, RANGE 18 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This township is situated between the crest of the Carson Range of the Sierra Nevadas and the east shore of Lake Tahoe, Nevada. Elevations within the portions resurveyed vary from 6200 feet at lake level to 8000 feet at the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36.

Access to the surveyed sections from Carson City is over U. S. Highway 50 and Spooner Summit located northeast of section 1. The junction of U. S. Highway 50 and State Highway 28 is located within section 1. Highway 28 follows the east lake shore to the communities at the north end of the lake. Highway 50 parallels the lake shore south of Glenbrook to the communities at the south end of the lake. A few unpaved roads and jeep trails give additional access to the Carson Range. The majority of the mountainous portion of the township is timbered and managed by the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit of the U. S. Forest Service located at South Lake Tahoe.

The community of Glenbrook is located at Glenbrook Bay in fractional section 10. Housing subdivisions are located along Highway 50 and the lake shore south of Glenbrook. Summer recreational activities include boating, hiking, bicycling, and operation of 4-wheel drive vehicles on the unpaved roads and jeep trails. There is limited winter recreation consisting mainly of cross country skiing and the operation of snowmobiles on the unpaved roads.
