## TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 65 EAST, MDM, NEVADA CHAINS GENERAL DESCRIPTION The area resurveyed within Township 41 North, Range 65 East, varies from nearly level to rolling land. The elevation ranges from about 5,300 to 5,700 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay and gravely on the higher elevations to black loam on the bottom land. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, rabbitbrush, greasewood, crested wheatgrass, meadow grass and other sparse native grass. There are scattered stands of willows along the Thousand Springs Creek which crosses the township in a northeasterly course. The Five Mile ranch house is located in section 10. Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by numerous improved and unimproved desert trail roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
