The elevation ranges from about 5,000 to 8,000 ft. above sea level, and is rolling to mountainous. The soil varies from sandy clay to gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, Brigham tea and native grass. There are scattered juniper and pinion on the higher elevations of little commercial value.</p> <p>There are numerous abandoned mines in the central portion of the area, which is known as the Fairview Mining District.</p> <p>Access into the area is provided by numerous improved and unimproved desert trail roads.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen, miners and the U.S. Navy.</p> <hr/>
