

SURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 25 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

From this corner, the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 25 E., bears WEST, 1.73 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.

Land, rolling.
 Soil, sandy clay and rocky.
 Undergrowth, sagebrush and bunchgrass.

The point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1 only, is on the S. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 25 E., and at 40.00 chs. in departure from the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land surveyed within Township 41 North, Range 25 East, ranges from about 5,200 to 6,100 ft. above sea level, and is rolling.

The soil varies from sandy clay to gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, bitterbrush and bunchgrass.

Soldier Creek, flows SW. through sections 12 and 13, and access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved desert trail roads throughout the area.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
