

	<p>From the closing cor. of secs. 6 and 31, Tps. 41 and 42 N., R. 26 E., hereinbefore described.</p> <p>N. 18°37' E., on a portion of line 5-6, of the Camp McGarry Military Reservation Line.</p> <p>Over rolling mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush and cheat grass.</p>
30.22	<p>Corner No. 6, on the Camp McGarry Military Reservation Line, monumented with a basalt stone, 24X12X12 ins., dimly mkd. N 6, firmly set in a mound of stone.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2¹/₂ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</p>
	
	<p>Deposit the original cornerstone alongside the stainless steel post.</p>
	<p>S. 72°11' E., on line 6-7, of the Camp McGarry Military Reservation Line.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, through scattered sagebrush, rabbitbrush, and meadow grass.</p>

21.84	The closing subdivision of section cor. of sec. 32, hereinafter described.

52.00	Trail road, bears NW. and SE.
