

TOWNSHIP 42 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 42 North, Range 26 East, varies from mountainous in the eastern portion to rolling in the western portion with the remaining terrain being gently rolling to nearly level. The elevation ranges from about 5,800 to 7,500 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from gravelly and rocky on the higher elevations to sand clay and loam on the bottom land. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, bitterbrush, rabbitbrush, meadow grass and other sparse native grasses. There are scattered stands of aspen and willows along Mahogany Creek, which flows southwesterly and Snow Creek, which flows northwesterly into Summit Lake, which is situated in the southwest corner of the township.

The tribal buildings for the Summit Lake Indian Reservation set in sections 20 and 21 and the Camp McGarry Ruins are in section 21.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during this survey.
