

TOWNSHIP 15 NORTH, RANGE 34 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land surveyed within T. 15 N., R. 34 E., is located in Bell Flat and the easterly slope of Fairview Mountain Range. The elevation ranges from 5,600 to 8,000 ft. above sea level. The southeasterly portion of the township is nearly level, while the northwesterly portion lies on the easterly slope of Fairview Mountains. The soil in the flat areas is sandy loam while the soil in the mountains is sandy clay to broken rocky outcrops. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, Brigham tea and native grass in the lower elevations. In the higher elevations there is juniper, pinion and mountain mahogany.

Access into the area is provided by a good graded road along the earthquake fault which runs in a north-south direction.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen.
