

RETRACEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE 1872 VON SCHMIDT SURVEY OF THE
EASTERN BOUNDARY OF CALIFORNIA, BETWEEN MILE
CORNERS 320 + 25 AND 330 + 26

CHAINS

Retracement of the Survey Executed by
U.S. Astronomer and Surveyor A.W. Von Schmidt in 1872

From the 320 + 25 Mile Corner, an unrecorded perpetuation by Nevada Planning Division (now Nevada Department of Transportation), monumented with an iron pipe, 1 in. diam., firmly set, flush with the ground and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original cor.

An alum. pipe, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set flush with the ground, established by Steven M. Dodds, Nevada Professional Land Surveyor, No. 7620, as recorded in Mineral County, Nevada, Document No. 108149,, with alum. cap mkd. "RM SCHMIDT NPD X 8.72 RLS 7620 1990" and an arrow pointing to the corner, bears N. 41°50' E., 13.2 lks. dist.

An alum. pipe, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set flush with the ground, established by Steven M. Dodds, Nevada Professional Land Surveyor, No. 7620, as recorded in Mineral County, Nevada, Document No. 108149, with alum. cap mkd. "RM SCHMIDT NPD 11.66 X RLS 7620 1990" and an arrow pointing to the corner, bears S. 41°50' W., 17.7 lks. dist.

S. 48°07'30" E. (mean bearing), on a transit line describing the true 1872 Von Schmidt Eastern Boundary of California.

Gradual ascent over a NW. facing slope, through sagebrush and native grasses.

- 6.035 The orig. closing cor. of secs. 27 and 34, T. 1 N., R. 32 E., hereinafter described.
- 20.094 The closing cor. of secs. 29 and 32, T. 1 N., R. 32 E., monumented with an alum. pipe, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 3 ins. above the ground, and in a collar of stone, 2 ft. base, 6 ins. high, determined by Steven M. Dodds, Nevada Professional Land Surveyor, No. 7620, as recorded in Mineral County, Nevada, Document No. 108149, with alum. cap mkd. "T1N R32E S29 S32 CC RLS7620 1990". This is accepted as a careful and faithful determination of the position of the cor.
- 26.30 Old Carson and Colorado railroad grade, 25 ft. wide, bears N. 43° E., and S. 43° W.
- 47.819 An alum. pipe, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, flush with the ground, and in a collar of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 ft. high, established by Steven M. Dodds, Nevada Professional Land Surveyor, No. 7620, as recorded in Mineral County, Nevada, Document No. 108149, with alum. cap mkd. "VON SCHMIDT LINE 1873 200.00 LT RLS7620 1990".
