A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears N.  $50\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  E.,  $49\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., mkd. T15N R18E S25 BT.

A granite outcrop, indeterminate size., bears S.  $41\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  E.,  $35\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist. to X, mkd. BXO on NW face,  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. above ground.

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.  $29\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  W.,  $108\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., mkd. T15N R18E S35 BT.

An aspen, 10 ins. diam., bears N.  $66\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  W., 89 lks. dist., mkd. T15N R18E S26 BT (bark scribed).

Cor. is located on moderate N slope, in area of sandy soil, decomposed granite boulders, thick aspen to the NW, fir and pine. Large granite outcrop to the W, 50 lks.

From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, on the E bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a stainless steel post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 2 ins. above a mound of stone,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. diam., with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the 1987-91 dependent resurvey of a portion of the W bdy. of T. 15 N., R. 19 E., executed under Group No. 647, from which the remains of the original bearing trees

A depression, with fir remnants, 12 ins. diam., bears N.  $47\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 112 lks. dist.

A fir bark ring, 24 ins. diam., bears S.  $63\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 169 lks. dist.

A depression, with pine bark pieces, 10 ins. diam., bears S.  $48\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 42 lks. dist.

and the remains of an unrecorded bearing tree

A red fir, 43 ins. diam., bears S.  $27\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E.,  $154\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., with foot blaze previously opened - chaining notch recovered.

and the 1987-91 bearing trees

A Jeffrey pine, 11 ins. diam., bears N.  $30^{\circ}$  E.,  $124\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., with the scribe marks T15N R19E S30 BT visible in blaze.

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S.  $63\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  E.,  $122\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., with the scribe marks T15N R19E S31 BT visible in blaze.
