

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the South Boundary,
T. 30 N., R. 58 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada

CHAINS

Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by
C. S. Swanholm, U. S. Cadastral Engineer,
in 1924

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set projecting 8 ins. above the ground, at corner of fences, bearing E. and S., with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 30 N., R. 58 E., executed under Group No. 103. There is no remains of the original post recovered in 1924.

From this corner, the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, T. 30 N., Rs. 58 and 59 E., identical with U.S.G.S. triangulation station "SEC COR 25/30N/58E", monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set projecting 8 ins. above the ground, at corner of fences, bearing N., S. and W., with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 30 N., R. 58 E., executed under Group No. 103, bears N. 63°40'00" E. (mean bearing), 179.22 chs. dist.

S. 89°58'30" W., on the S. bdy. of sec. 34.

Over rolling mountainous land, covered with medium sagebrush and native grass, with widely scattered quaking aspen and mountain mahogany.

15.50 Mayhew Creek, 10 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, course irregularly ESE.

35.60 Spur, slopes ESE.

37.45 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 34, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 30 N., R. 58 E., executed under Group No. 103, from which the original bearing tree

A mahogany, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 170 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 BT on open blaze.

Add the marks T30N R58E 1993 to the brass cap.

S. 89°59'00" W., beginning new measurement.

2.55 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 3 only, T. 29 N., R. 58 E., hereinafter described.

26.80 Ridge, bears NNE. and SSW.

39.82 The cor. of secs. 33 and 34, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 30 N., R. 58 E., executed under Group No. 103. Add the marks 1993 to the brass cap.

S. 89°57'00" W., on the S. bdy. of sec. 33.

Over mountainous land, covered with medium sagebrush and native grass, with widely scattered scrub juniper and mountain mahogany.

6.49 The closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, T. 29 N., R. 58 E., hereinafter described.
