

## TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 63 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

The vertical angles of measurements made on the slope were ascertained with a theodolite in good adjustment; the horizontal equivalents only are entered in the field notes.

The geographic position for the northeast corner of the township is at latitude 41°28'29.41" N. and longitude 114°46'51.75" W., (NAD 27), as calculated from a direct tie to U.S.C. & G.S. triangulation station "RED POINT".

The mean magnetic declination is 17<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>° E., as shown on the U.S.G.S. 7.5 minute quadrangle maps "LOOMIS MTN., NEV. and WILKINS, NEV.", dated 1968.

From the standard cor. of Tps. 40<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and 41 N., Rs. 62<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and 63 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 40<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> N., R. 63 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.

N. 6°04' E., on the W. bdy. of sec. 31 and the E. bdy. of sec. 6, T. 40<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> N., R. 62<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E.

Over rolling land, covered with medium sagebrush, scattered willows, cacti and native grass.

- 11.70 Trail road, parallels buried A. T. & T. telecommunications line.
- 11.90 Buried A. T. & T. telecommunications line, bears E. and W.
- 20.950 The standard closing cor. of Tps. 40<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and 41 N., Rs. 62 and 62<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 41 N., R. 62 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.
- Continue measurement on the W. bdy. of sec. 31.
- 41.00 Point for the <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. This cor. will now refer to the <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> sec. cor. of sec. 31 only.

- 44.50 Pole Creek, 15 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, course irregularly E.
- 61.094 The E <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 41 N., R. 62 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 41 N., R. 62 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.
