Over rolling land, covered with scattered sagebrush and native grass.

1.455 Intersect the E. bdy. of sec. 1, T. 40 N., R. 62 E.

Point for the closing cor. of Tps. 40¹/₂ N., Rs. 62¹/₂ and 63 E.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2¹/₂ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
