Continue measurement across sec. 1, T. 40 N., R. 62 E., on a blank line.

The closing cor. of T. 40 N., Rs. 62 and 63 E., monumented with the decayed remains of a wooden post, no scribe marks visible, loosely set in a mound of earth. This cor. will now become an amended monument. Bury the decayed remains of the original wooden post in place.

From the S $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 63 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the T. 40 N., R. 64 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.

N. 88°45' W., on the S. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 63 E.

Over mountainous land, covered with scattered sagebrush and native grass.

The standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 41 N., R. 63 E., monumented with a redwood post, 3 ins. square, 36 ins. long, with illegible scribe marks visible, loosely set in a mound of earth. This cor. will now refer to the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ N., R. 63 E.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
