Set a galvanized channel iron, 4¹/₂ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.

From this corner, Angle Point No. 6, Tract 46, hereinbefore described, bears S. 88°50' E., 3.453 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 40 North, Range 64 East is situated about 21 miles north of Wells, Nevada. The elevation varies from 5600 to 7500 feet above sea level. The vegetation consists of sagebrush rabbitbrush, bitterbrush, crested wheat grass, cacti and native grass in the lower elevations with juniper, mountain mahogany and pinon pine in the higher elevations.

The township is drained by Brush Creek which flows northerly from springs located in sec. 21 and West Brush Creek which flows northeasterly from the W. bdy. of the township.

The area is accessed by State Highway No. 93, which crosses the township through section 6. Further access to the township is provided by numerous trail roads. The only permanent housing is located in section 15. Principal users of the area are people raising cattle. There has been some mining activity in the southwest portion of the township.
