

T. 21 S., R. 63 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within the resurveyed portion of Township 21 South, Range 63 East, located on the east side of Henderson, Nevada, ranges from 1,700 to 2,500 ft. above sea level. The land is mostly mountainous with some rolling land in parts of sections 27 and 34. There are extensive tailings and an open pit mine in section 35 where the greatest part of the patented mineral surveys are located. The soil is sandy or rocky. The vegetation consists of creosote brush, mesquite brush, various cacti and native grasses.

Access is provided by Lake Mead Drive, asphalt surfaced, and various paved, gravel and trail roads leading off of it.

Principal users of the area are ultralight aircraft fliers using the tailings as a runway and landing field.
