From this corner, U. S. C. & G. S. triangulation station "CONCH", monumented with a standard brass tablet, set in concrete on rock outcrop, mkd. "CONCH 1958," bears N. 68°07.5' E. (MEAN BEARING), 155.20 chs. dist.

From the cor. of Tps. 25 and 26 S., Rs. 59 and 60 E.

N. 0°03.8' E., bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over rolling land, covered with scattered creosote brush, yuccas, various cacti and native grass.

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 2 ins. in the ground, over x chiseled in solid bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
