	GENERAL LAND DESCRIPTION
	The area resurveyed within Township 29 South, Range 59 East, ranges in elevation from 2800 to 3200 ft. above sea level. The east boundary runs along the western, lower slope of Sheep Mountains, the rest being gently rolling. The soil varies from sandy loam to gravelly and rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of creosote brush, yuccas, various cacti and native grasses.
	Access to the area is provided by Interstate 15 crossing the area entering the township in section 33 and exiting the township in section 1 in a northeasterly direction, State Route No. 604 which roughly parallels Interstate 15 and State Route No. 161 which begins in section 13 and exits the township in section 5 in a west-northwesterly direction. The Union Pacific Railroad crosses the area entering the township in section 35 and exits the township in section 12 in a northeasterly direction. The town of Jean is located within sections 11, 12, 13 and 14. There is also an unpatented millsite located in sections 22 and 27.
