

SURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 6 S., R. 56 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADACHAINS
80.06

The cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26, monumented with a stainless steel post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 6 S., R. 56 E., executed under Group No. 667.

Land, rolling.

Soil, sandy loam clay and rocky.

Undergrowth, bitterbrush, Brigham tea, native grass, scattered Joshua trees and yuccas.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed within Township 6 South, Range 56 East, is about 5,200 to 6,400 ft. above sea level. The land is rolling to mostly mountainous with sandy clay loam and rocky soil. The vegetation consists of Brigham tea, bitter brush and native grass. There are scattered Joshua trees and yuccas throughout the township.

Access into the township is provided by some trail roads.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen.
