	<p>Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the 1978 resurvey.</p>
	<p>N. $89^{\circ}17'$ W., bet. secs. 4 and 9.</p>
37.946	<p>Intersect a fence which bears N-S; point for a witness point.</p>
	<p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.</p>

	<p>From this corner the corner of fences projecting N and W bears S. $0^{\circ}50'$ E., 94 lks. dist.</p>
40.174	<p>The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the 1978 resurvey, and a mound of stone west of the corner.</p>
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	<p>N. $1^{\circ}29'$ E., bet. secs. 4 and 5.</p>
40.660	<p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set 6 ins. below the surface of a graded road which bears E-W, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the 1978 resurvey; there is no remaining evidence of the reference monuments set in 1978.</p>
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	<p>N. $1^{\circ}29'$ E., beginning new measurement.</p>
40.996	<p>The cor. of secs. 4 and 5, on the north boundary of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the 1914 resurvey executed by W. A. Pray.</p>
	<p>Corner is located at the corner of fences projecting S and E.</p>
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
