	<p>Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by C.S. Swanholm in 1930-33</p>
	<p>Beginning at the corner of sections 1, 2, 35 and 36, monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., projecting 8 ins. above the ground, with brass cap marked as described in the field notes of the 1930-33 survey, and a mound of stone W. of the corner; add the marks 1993 to the cap.</p> <p>S. 89°57.7' W., between sections 2 and 35, on the northerly boundary of a utility right-of-way corridor.</p>
39.969	<p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner of sections 2 and 35, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., projecting 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap marked as described in the field notes of the 1930-33 survey, and a mound of stone N. of the corner; remark the cap to read as follows:</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>T18S R63E S35 1/4 ——— S 2 T19S 1993 1933</p> </div>
	<p>S. 89°58.0' W., beginning new measurement.</p>
35.162	<p>Intersect the easterly right-of-way of Interstate Highway No. 15.</p> <p>Point for a witness point between sections 2 and 35.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2$\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, over a DEEP-1 magnetic marker and in a collar of stone, with brass cap marked:</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>WP T18S R63E ROW / S35 115 / S 2 R63E T19S 1993</p> </div>
40.011	<p>From this witness point a Nevada Highway Department station, monumented with a standard brass tablet, set in concrete, flush with the surface of the ground, marked OE821+38.91POT DIST 57.41 ANGLE 90, bears N. 19°01.7' E., 8.820 chs. dist.</p> <p>Point for the corner of sections 2, 3, 34 and 35 at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set a brass tablet, 3$\frac{1}{4}$ ins. diam., 3$\frac{1}{2}$ in. stem, in concrete, over a rebar, 5/8 in. diam., 18 ins. long, flush with the surface of the ground at the easterly edge of the pavement of the southbound lanes of Interstate Highway No. 15, with top marked:</p>
