

TOWNSHIP 12 NORTH, RANGE 42 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

The geographic position for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 19, on the W. bdy. of T. 12 N., R. 43 E., is at Lat. $38^{\circ}53'12.14''$ N. and Long. $117^{\circ}11'59.32''$ W. - NAD 83 (1986), as calculated from a direct tie to U.S.G.S. Bench Mark (triangulation station) "BM 5830".

The mean magnetic declination is $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., as shown on U.S.G.S. quadrangle maps "CARVERS, NEV. and CARVERS NW, NEV.", both dated 1971.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 30, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 12 N., R. 43 E., executed under Group No. 556. This cor. will now refer to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 30 only.

Over nearly level land, covered with medium sagebrush, scattered shadscale, Brigham tea, rabbitbrush, cacti and native grass.

- 8.40 Bladed road, bears WNW. and ESE.
- 39.919 The closing cor. of secs. 13 and 24, T. 12 N., R. 42 E., hereinafter described.
- 40.276 The cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 12 N., R. 43 E., executed under Group No. 556. This cor. will now refer to the cor. of secs. 19 and 30 only.
