0.574	<p>The closing cor. of the NE cor. of T. 12 N., R. 42 E., hereinafter described.</p>
40.562	<p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 12 N., R. 43 E., executed under Group No. 556. 39.732	<p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, monumented with a granite stone, 19x7x5 ins., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, firmly set in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.</p>
