CHAINS 4.70	Trail road, bears irregularly N. and S.
9.917	A.P. No. 2, Tract 37, T. 40 N., R. 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 40 N., R. 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., executed under Group No. 48, bears SOUTH, 0.318 chs. dist.
39.434	The standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 40 N., R. 23 E., executed under Group No. 48. From the standard cor. of Tps. 41 N., Rs. 23 and 24 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set showing 12 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 40 N., R. 23 E., executed under Group No. 48. This cor. will now refer to the standard cor. of Tps. 41 N., Rs. 23 and 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.	
N. 1°14'10" E., on the E. bdy. of sec. 36.	
Over rolling land, covered with medium sagebrush, scattered rabbitbrush and native grass.	
41.574	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. This cor. will now refer to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36 only. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd. <div style="text-align: center;"> T41N R23E R23 1/2E 1/4 S36 1989 </div>
Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.	
83.148	Point for the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
