	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The land within Township 41 North, Range 23 East, Ranges from about 5,200 ft. to 6,100 ft. above sea level and is mostly rolling. The soil is sandy clay loam and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, rabbitbrush and native grass.
	The township is drained by High Rock Canyon and Pole Canyon, draining to the south. Pole Canyon is made up of three drainages, Cottonwood Creek, Wall Canyon Creek and the wash from Hanging Rock Canyon.
	Access to the township is provided by several secondary roads from Route No. 8A to the north. There are several desert trail roads scattered throughout the township.
	Yellow Hills Well is located in the northwestern portion of sec. 10.
	No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
