17.712	N. 81°29'20" E., on line 2-3. Intersect the line between secs. 19 and 20. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd. WP S19 S20 1997
58.307	Intersect the N-S center line of sec. 20. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd. WP C S 20 C 1997
75.632	Point for Angle Point No. 3. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. AP3 T23S R62E S19 1997
	GENERAL DESCRIPTION The average elevation of the area surveyed is about 3000 feet. General drainage is to the northwest. Vegetation consists of creosote and cacti.
