

## CHAINS 1.670

Point for Angle Point No. 2.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long,  $2^{1}/_{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.



From this point, the witness point between sections 8 and 17 on the southerly right-of-way line of Interstate Highway No. 15, bears S. 65°11'00" W., 41.135 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.

s. 4°57′20" W., on line 2-3.

Intersect the line between sections 8 and 17 at the point for Angle Point No. 3.
