| 63.162 | <p>Point for the N 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">N 1/16 S36 S31 1999</p> |
| 75.70 | Smith Creek, 10 lks. wide, course East. |
| 84.216 | <p>The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, perpetuated by Keith N. Meador, Nevada Professional Land Surveyor No. 1004, monumented with a 60d nail set flush with the surface of the ground, in the remains of a concrete encasement; there is no remaining evidence of the iron post as recorded under File No. 35994, Office of the County Clerk and Recorder of the County of Lander, State of Nevada. This is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.</p> |
