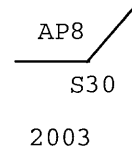
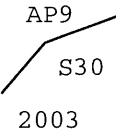
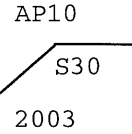


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METES-AND-BOUNDS SURVEYS IN SECTION 30,

CHAINS	 N. 17°02'20" E., on line 8-9. 9.160 Point for Angle Point No. 9, sec. 30. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.  N. 54°07'30" E., on line 9-10. 5.724 Point for Angle Point No. 10, sec. 30. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.  S. 88°31'50" E., on line 10-11. 5.591 Angle Point No. 11, sec. 30, identical with Angle Point No. 1, sec. 29, of this survey, on the line bet. secs. 29 and 30, hereinbefore described. GENERAL DESCRIPTION The average elevation of the area surveyed is about 3000 feet. General drainage is to the northwest. Vegetation consists of creosote and cacti.
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
