RM WP 61.07 FT TO COR S29 2006 and an arrow pointing to the corner. GENERAL DESCRIPTION The area resurveyed and surveyed within Township 19 South, Range 60 East, is situated in the City of Las Vegas. The land is nearly level and the elevation is approximately 2300 feet above sea level. The soil is sandy and gravelly. The vegetation consists of creosote, shadscale, and cacti. Access into the area is provided by paved streets. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
