Benson in 1881 From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, 3 ft. diam., 6 ins. high, as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the north boundary of T. 12 S., R. 63 E., executed concurrently under this same Group. N. 1°27'30" W., bet. secs. 31 and 32. Over rolling hills.

39.880	Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.
	Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

79.760	The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, monumented with an unmarked lava stone, 14x12x9 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, 2 ft. diam., 2 ft. high. At the corner point Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
