

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 35 N., R. 37 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS	T35N R37E S 9 1/4 <u> </u> S16 2006 Deposit rebar inside stainless steel post. N. 88°55'50" W., beginning new measurement. Over nearly level land through scattered sagebrush. 14.324 Point for the witness point at intersection with the centerline of Old U.S. Highway No. 40, hereinafter described. 19.791 Point for the W 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 9 and 16. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd. W 1/16 <u> </u> S 9 S16 2006 39.582 The cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17. SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 16, T. 35 N., R. 37 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA From the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21, monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 35 N., R. 37 E., executed under Group No. 427. Mound of stone 2 ft. base, 12 ins. high, N. of iron post. N. 0°29'00" E., on the N-S center line of sec. 16. Over nearly level land through scattered sagebrush. 26.70 Powerline bears N. 63° E., S. 63° W. 26.80 Graded dirt road, 10 lks. wide, bears N. 63° E., S. 63° W. Road parallels powerline. 44.060 The center 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 16, determined by John H. Milton, Nevada Professional Land Surveyor No. 5271, monumented with a rebar, 5/8 in. diam., flush with ground, with plastic cap mkd. J.H. Milton, PLS 5271, as recorded in Humboldt County, Nevada, Document No. 1997 8272. This is accepted as a careful and faithful determination of the position of the corner.
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
