	<p>Beginning at the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33, monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 26 ins. above the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 1/2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 23 S., R. 61 E., executed under Group No. 364.</p>

	<p>A chiseled X followed by the letters BO, bears N. 9°47' E., 16.7 lks. dist., mkd. on the top of an igneous outcrop, 4x4x2 ft. high.</p>
	<p>A chiseled X followed by the letters BO, bears S. 87°59' E., 42.7 lks. dist., mkd. on exposed bedrock, 9x5x1/2 ft. high, 1 ft. from W. edge.</p>
	<p>Add the marks T23S R61E 2005 to brass cap.</p>
	<p>N. 89°57'50" W., bet. secs. 4 and 33.</p>
	<p>Over mountainous land, through scattered undergrowth.</p>
23.30	<p>Toe of slope, bears N. 40° W. and S. 40° E.</p>
23.497	<p>Point for Angle Point No. 1, of a metes-and-bounds survey in sec. 33.</p>
	<p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.</p>
