CHAINS	<p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, over a plastic encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T19S R62E 1/4 S19 S20 2006</p> <hr/> <p>N. 0°04'40" E., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, along the eastern edge of Lamb Boulevard (asphalt).</p> <p>27.63 The centerline of the east bound lanes of Clark County Highway No. 215, 53 lks. wide, bears E. and W.</p> <p>37.86 The centerline of the west bound lanes of Clark County Highway No. 215, 53 lks. wide, bears E. and W.</p> <p>40.850 The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 1 in. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 19 S., R. 62 E., under Group No. 780.</p> <p>Cor. is located at the intersection of fences extending N., E. and W.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed within Township 19 South, Range 62 East, is situated in the City of North Las Vegas. The land is nearly level and there is a residential subdivision S. of the south line of Section 19. The average elevation is approximately 2100 feet above sea level. The soil is sandy and gravely and the vegetation consists of creosote and cacti.</p> <p>Access into the area is provided by paved streets.</p> <hr/>
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
