	Reestablishment of a Portion of the Surveys Executed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor E.B. Monroe in 1874 and U.S. Deputy Surveyors G.W. Conklin and T.K. Stewart in 1882
	From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a stainless steel post, firmly set flush with the surface of the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the N. bdy. of T. 19 N., R. 31 E., executed under Group No. 719.
	N. 0°04'30" W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.
	Over nearly level land covered with greasewood, rabbit brush, sagebrush and native grass.
14.50	Improved gravel road, bears NE. and SW.
40.343	Point for the $1/4$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.
