78.790	<p>The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 18 and 19, monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the subdivisional lines of T. 17 S., R. 50 E., executed under Group No. 408, with a mound of stone, 2 ft. diam., W. of cor.</p> <hr/> <p>From the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 20.</p> <p>S. 88°44'20" W., on the E-W center line of sec. 19.</p> <p>Over rolling land.</p>

19.990	<p>The SE 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 19, determined by U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, monumented with a rebar, 3/4 in. diam., 30 ins. long, firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above the ground, with aluminum cap mkd. SE 1/16 S19 1987. This monument is locally recognized as the position of the corner point, and is accepted as a careful and faithful determination of the position of the corner.</p>
