	<p data-bbox="451 331 1442 548">The lands dependently resurveyed and subdivided within Township 17 South, Range 50 East are part of the Ash Meadows National Wildlife Refuge located in the Amargosa Desert, and ranges from about 2,100 to 3,100 ft. above sea level. The terrain is nearly level to low mountainous. The soil is sandy clay loam in the lower elevations to rocky in the higher elevations and vegetation consists of scattered mesquite and native grass.</p> <p data-bbox="451 575 1409 705">Access to the area is provided by numerous improved roads, unimproved roads, and trail roads. Carson Slough drains the area from north to south leaving in section 32. There are numerous springs in the area, and the Death Valley National Monument is located in section 36.</p> <hr data-bbox="451 730 1474 737"/>
