13.404	<p>Intersect the Idaho-Nevada State Line.</p> <p>The closing cor. of secs. 1 and 6, monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above the ground, in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the east boundary of T. 47 N., R. 51 E., executed under Instructions dated April 27, 1911. 13.00	Owyhee River, 2 chs. wide, course NW.; enter rolling land.
14.90	Nevada State Route 225, asphalt-surfaced, 45 lks. wide, on curve bearing S. 60° E. and N. 60° W.
19.997	<p>Point for the 1/16 sec. cor. No. 12, bet. secs. 35 and 36 (S1/2) at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. This point will now be referred to as the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">S 1/16 S35   S36</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2005</p> <p>Set a steel sign post, 6 ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.</p>
