

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY,
T. 19 N., R. 31 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS	<p>Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by E.B. Monroe, Deputy Surveyor, in 1868, and a Portion of the Resurvey Executed by S.R. Lambeth, Cadastral Surveyor, in 1992</p> <hr/> <p>Beginning at the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the independent resurvey of a portion of the S. bdy., executed under Group No. 719, with steel fence post alongside, and a mound of stone, 2 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>N. 89°51'20" W., bet. secs. 4 and 33.</p> <p>Over nearly level land covered with shad scale, Brigham tea and sagebrush.</p> <p>11.20 Trail road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 9° E. and S. 9° W.</p> <p>40.051 The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33, monumented with a basalt stone, 10x8x6 ins., firmly set, projecting 3 ins. above the ground, plainly mkd. 1/4 on the N. face.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over plastic-encased magnet, with cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>T19N R31E S33 1/4 <u> </u> S 4 T18N</p> <p>2007</p> </div> <p>Deposit the basalt stone alongside the stainless steel post.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 89°51'50" W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over nearly level land covered with shad scale, Brigham tea and sagebrush.</p> <p>40.060 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, monumented with a basalt stone, 14x12x10 ins., firmly set, projecting 7 ins. above the ground, plainly mkd. with 4 grooves on the E. face and 2 grooves on the W. face.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over plastic-encased magnet, in a collar of stone, 2 1/2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.</p>
