Benson and C.F. Putnam in 1881</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above the ground, and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the W. bdy. of T. 11 S., R. 63 E., executed under Group No. 824.</p> <p>S. 89°50'00" W., bet. secs. 25 and 36.</p> <p>Over flats covered with creosote, chaparral and scattered cacti.</p> <p>4.60 Dry wash, 50 lks. wide, drains SE.</p> <p>21.90 Dry wash, 40 lks. wide, drains NE.</p> <p>40.003 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T11S R62E S25 1/4 <hr/>S36</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2006</p> <p>40.20 Dry wash, 30 lks. wide, drains NE.</p> <p>80.006 The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, monumented with a limestone, 17x7x6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 ft. high, mkd. with 1 groove on S. and 1 groove on E. face.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.</p>
