Soil, very sandy with rocks. Undergrowth, some shadscale and native grasses.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land included in this survey is located in Esmeralda County, Nevada. The elevation goes from about 4750 to 5300 feet in elevation. The soil ranges from alkali in the flats to sandy with rocks in the hills. The undergrowth consists of shadscale and native grasses. Access to the area consists of Nevada State Route 265 and numerous dirt roads. The closest town is Silver Peak, located on Nevada State Route 265, approximately 5 miles south of the township.</p> <hr/>
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
