

SURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 1 N., R. 39 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

Land, low hills and dry washes.
Soil, very sandy with rocks.
Undergrowth, some shadscale and native grasses.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land included in this survey is located in Esmeralda County, Nevada. The elevation ranges from about 5000 to 5300 feet in elevation. The soil ranges from alkali in the flats to sandy and rocky in the hills. The undergrowth consists of shadscale and native grasses. There is evidence of prospecting in the area and no improvements within section 31. Access to the area consists of numerous trail roads. The town of Silver Peak is located on Nevada State Route 265, approximately 9 miles south of the township.
